

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS IN DISTRICT AND CITY OF CARLISLE)  
(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO.2) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Utility works to be carried out (“the Works”), Cumberland Council intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along the following sections of road:

1. U2256 Meadow Road, Wigton, from its junction with Wampool Place, extending in a north easterly direction for approx.30m.

There is no suitable alternative route available for vehicles

**Duration: From 7 February 2024 for approx. 1 day (Ref: TTROC/9507)**

2. U7004 Manor Court, Wigton from its junction with Union Street, extending in a south westerly direction for approx.30m.

Alternative Route: via the unrestricted section of Manor Court, West Street and Union Street.

**Duration: From 8 February 2024 for approx. 1 day (Ref: TTROC/9605)**

3. U1202 Brier Lonning, from its junction with Acre Close, to its junction with the A69.

Alternative Route: via the unrestricted section of Brier Lonning, U1199, U1201 and A69.

**Duration: From 9 February 2024 for approx. 1 day (Ref: TTROC/9593)**

4. C2049 Raughton Head, from its junction with the C1018, to its junction with the U1141.

Alternative Route: via the unrestricted sections of the C2049, B5305 and B5299.

**Duration: From 14 February 2024 for approx. 1 day (Ref: TTROC/9515)**

5. C1007 Penton, Carlisle from its junction the B6318, extending in a north easterly direction for approx. 1.1 km.

Alternative Route: via the unrestricted section of the C1007, C1008 and B6318.

**Duration: From 27 February 2024 for approx. 1 day (Ref: TTROC/9820)**

6. C1013 Newby East, from its junction with Little Corby Road, extending in a north easterly direction for approx. 260m.

Alternative Route: via the unrestricted section of the C1013, A689, U1181 and U1183

**Duration: From 28 February 2024 for approx. 1 day (Ref: TTROC/9675)**

7. Ellesmere Way, Carlisle from its junction with Scale Hill, to its junction with Easdale Bank.

Alternative Route: via the unrestricted section of Ellesmere Way, Glendale Rise, and Easdale Bank

**Duration: From 22 March 2024 for approx. 1 day (Ref: TTROC/9642)**

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation on 7 February 2024 and may continue in force for a maximum duration of eighteen months. However, please note that it is anticipated that the restrictions will only be required as detailed above, and only as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.
