

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (U2160 LING LANE, NEAR WELTON, U1107 TREE ROAD,
BRAMPTON AND U1292 HAWKSDALE) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION)
ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable highway works to be carried out (“the Works”), Cumberland Council intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along the following sections of road:

1. U2160 Ling Lane, near Welton, from its junction with the entrance to the property known as ‘Ling Side’, extending in a south westerly direction for approx. 100m.

Alternative Route: via the unrestricted sections of the U2160, U2159, B5299 Welton and the U1138.

Duration: From 2 January 2025 for approx. 5 days (Ref: TTROC/12667)

2. U1107 Tree Road, Brampton, from its junction with the B6413 Craw Hall/Tarn Road, extending in a north easterly direction for approx. 220m.

Alternative Route: via the unrestricted section of Tree Road, C1047 Station Road, A6071 Main Street and B6413 Front Street and Craw Hall.

Duration: From 13 January 2025 for approx. 12 days (Ref: TTROC/12732)

3. U1292 Hawksdale, from its junction with the entrance to Hawksdale Farm, extending in a north easterly direction for approx. 180 m.

There is no suitable alternative route available for vehicles.

Duration: From 27 January 2025 for approx. 12 days (Ref: TTROC/12871)

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation on 2 January 2025 and may continue in force for a maximum duration of eighteen months. However, please note that it is anticipated that the restrictions will only be required as detailed above, and only as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.
