NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable highway works to be carried out ("the Works"), Cumberland Council intends to make an Order the effect of which is to:

- 1. Prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along the following sections of road:
 - i) A595 Holmrook, from its junction with the B5344, extending in an overall southerly direction for approx. 4.8km.

<u>Alternative Route for vehicles which are permitted to use the Motorway</u>: via the unrestricted sections of the A595, A5092, A590, M6 and A66.

Duration: From 29 July 2024 for approx. 1 month between 1900 and 0500 hours (Ref: TTROC/11059)

ii) A595 Ravenglass, from its junction with Corney Fell Road, extending in an overall northerly direction for approx. 3.6km.

<u>Alternative Route</u>: via the unrestricted sections of the A595, A5092, A590, A591 and A66. Duration: From 9 September 2024 for approx. 1 month between 1900 and 0500 hours (Ref: TTROC/11060)

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.

- 2. Prohibit any vehicle from proceeding at speeds in excess of 30 miles per hour along the following sections of road:
 - ii) A595 Holmrook, from its junction with the B5344, extending in an overall southerly direction for approx. 4.8 km.

Duration: From 29 July 2024 for approx. 1 month between 0500 and 1900 hours (Ref: TTROC/11059)

ii) A595 Ravenglass, from its junction with Corney Fell Road, extending in an overall northerly direction for approx. 3.6km.

Duration: From 9 September 2024 for approx. 1 month between 0500 and 1900 hours (Ref: TTROC/11060)

No speed limit imposed by this Order will apply to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

The Order will come into operation on 29 July 2024 and may continue in force for a maximum duration of eighteen months. However, please note that it is anticipated that the restrictions will only be required as detailed above, and only as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.
