

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (C4017 WATH BROW, CLEATOR MOOR)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF ALL TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable utility works to be carried out (“the Works”), Cumberland Council intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit all traffic (i.e. vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists), from proceeding along that section of the C4017 Wath Brow, Cleator Moor, from a point adjacent to the property known as ‘The Wath’ extending in a north westerly direction for approx. 30m.

A suitable alternative route for vehicles will be signed and available via the unrestricted sections of the C4017, U4032, A595 and A5086.

The Order will come into operation on 9 April 2024 and may continue in force for a maximum duration of eighteen months. However, please note that it is anticipated that the restriction will only be required for **3 days** and only as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.
