ADVISORY NOTICE

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS IN THE DISTRICT OF CARLISLE) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024

Cumberland Council made an order to enable utility works to be carried out ("the Works") which came into operation on 30 January 2024.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along that section of the U1292 Hawksdale, Near Dalston from its junction with the C2049, extending in an easterly then northerly direction for approx. 960m.

The Works have been rescheduled and will now be carried out under the provisions of the above stated Order on 12th August 2024 and is expected to be in place for an approx. duration of 5 days, as and when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.

Nothing in the Order to which this notice relates shall:

- 1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
- 2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
- 3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
- 4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Works.
