ADVISORY NOTICE

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS IN THE DISTRICT AND CITY OF CARLISLE)

(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO.4) ORDER 2024

Cumberland Council made an order to enable highway works to be carried out ("the Works") which came into operation on 7 May 2024.

One of the effects of the Order is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along that section of the C2042 Kirkandrews-on-Eden and Monkhill from its junction with A689 Burgh Road Roundabout, extending in a north westerly direction for approx. 3.2 km.

The Works have been rescheduled and will now be carried out under the provisions of the above stated Order on 9 September 2024 and is expected to be in place for an approx. duration of 5 days, as and when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times and a suitable alternative route for vehicles will be signed and available via the unrestricted section of the C2042, U2001 Glasson, C2053, B5307 Kirkbampton, Thurstonfield and Moorhouse and the A689.

Nothing in the Order to which this notice relates shall:

- 1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
- 2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
- 3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
- 4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Works.
