

ADVISORY NOTICE

CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS IN THE CUMBERLAND AREA)

(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO.11) ORDER 2024

Cumberland Council made an order to enable Levelling Up Highway Improvement works to be carried out ("the Works") which came into operation on 8 April 2024.

One of the effects of the Order is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along that section of the A595 Waberthwaite from a point approx. 200m north east of its junction with C4027, extending in an overall southerly direction for approx. 1.6km.

The Works have been rescheduled and will now be carried out under the provisions of the above stated Order on 2nd May 2025 and is expected to be in place for an approx. duration of 10 hours, as and when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.

Alternative route as below:

Vehicles: via the unrestricted section of the A595, A5092, A591 and A66.

Vehicles exceeding 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight (HGV's) and vehicles exceeding 6'6" in width: via the A595, A5092, M6 (if permitted) and A66.

Nothing in the Order to which this notice relates shall:

1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Works.
