

ADVISORY NOTICE

**CUMBERLAND COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, BRIDEKIRK, B5301 OUTGANG ROAD, ASPATRIA AND C2033
BLINDCRAKE)**

(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2026

Cumberland Council made an order to enable utility works to be carried out ("the Works") which came into operation on 16 July 2026.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along that section of the B5301 Outgang Road, Aspatria from its junction with the A596, extending in a north easterly direction for approx 60m.

The Works have been rescheduled and will now be carried out under the provisions of the above stated Order on 17th August 2026 and is expected to be in place for an approx. duration of 22 days, as and when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times and a suitable alternative route for vehicles will be signed and available via the B5301 Outgang Road, North Road and the A596.

Nothing in the Order to which this notice relates shall:

1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Works.
