EMERGENCY TEMPORARY 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT NOTICE A595, WREAKS CAUSEWAY, GRIZEBECK

Notice is hereby given, that because of the likelihood of danger to the public, as a result of the dangerous condition to the bridge, Westmorland and Furness Council hereby prohibits with immediate effect any vehicle from proceeding at speeds in excess of 30 miles per hour along the section of the A595 Wreaks Causeway, Grizebeck, from its junction with the C5013, extending in a predominantly northerly direction for a distance of approx. 2 km.

This notice will be in force for a period of up to 21 days from 17th January 2024, as and when the relevant signs are displayed. It is anticipated that the restriction will be required for 1 day between the hours of 11.00am and 11.30am.

No speed limit imposed by this Order will apply to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
