Notice is hereby given that to enable Cadent Gas to carry out urgent utility repair works ("the Works") Westmorland and Furness Council prohibits with immediate effect the passage of vehicles along that section of Church Street, Broughton-In-Furness from its junction with Station Road extendign in a westerly direction for a distance of approx. 60 metres, as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.

This notice will be in force for a period not exceeding 5 days from 23rd October 2023. It is expected that the Works will take 5 days.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times and a suitable alternative route will be signed and made available as follows;

South west bound traffic: Via the unrestricted sections of Church Street, Griffin Street, Market Street, Foxfield Road and the A595.

<u>East bound traffic:</u> Via the unrestricted section of Church Street, A595, Foxfield Road, Market Street, Station Road, Prince's Street and Griffin Street.



Nothing in this Notice shall:

- 1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
- 2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform: and
- 3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
- 4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Works.
