
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14(2)

URGENT PROHIBITION OF ALL TRAFFIC NOTICE CHURCH STREET, BROUGHTON-IN-FURNESS

Notice is hereby given that to enable Westmorland and Furness Highways to carry out urgent highway repair works ("the Works") Westmorland and Furness Council prohibits with immediate effect the passage of all traffic (i.e. vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists) along that section of Church Street, Broughton-In-Furness, from its junction with Griffin Street, extending in a north westerly direction to its junction with the A593, as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.

This notice will be in force for a period not exceeding 5 days from 3rd May 2024. It is expected that the Works will take 1 day.

A suitable alternative route will be signed and made available via the A593, C5009, New Street, Market Street and Station Road.



Nothing in this Notice shall:

- 1. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
- 2. Apply to vehicles and personnel being used in connection with the Works.
