URGENT PROHIBITION OF ALL TRAFFIC

C3039 GARRIGILL

Notice is hereby given that to enable Northumbrian Water to carry out urgent utility repair works ("the Works") Westmorland and Furness Council prohibits with immediate effect the passage of all traffic (i.e. vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists) along that section of the C3039 Garrigill, from a point approx. 550m north west of its junction with the U3117, extending in a southwesterly direction for a distance of approx. 115 m, as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.

This notice will be in force for a period not exceeding 5 days from 24th March 2025. It is expected that the Works will take 5 days.

A suitable alternative route for vehicles will be available via the unrestricted sections of C3039, A686, B6277 and C3039.



Nothing in the Order shall:

(ii) Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and

(iii) Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the road or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the road; and

(iv) Apply to vehicles or personnel being used in connection with the Works.(v) Apply other than at such times and to such extent as is indicated by the appropriate traffic signs
