URGENT ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE SILVERDALE ROAD, ARNSIDE

Notice is hereby given that to enable Westmorland and Furness Highways to carry out urgent tree felling works ("the Works") Westmorland and Furness Council prohibits with immediate effect the passage of vehicles along that section of Silverdale Road, Arnside, from its junction with Red Hills Lane, extending in a north westerly direction for a distance of approx 150 metres, as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.

This notice will be in force for a period not exceeding 5 days from 19th December 2025. It is expected that the Works will take 1 day.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.

A suitable alternative route for vehicles will be available via the unrestricted sections of Silverdale Road (C5096), Briery Bank, Black Dyke Road and the B5282.



Nothing in the Order shall:

- (i) Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
- (ii) Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the road or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the road; and
- (iii) Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Works.
