ADVISORY NOTICE

WESTMORLAND AND FURNESS COUNCIL

(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2023

OXENHOLME LANE, NATLAND

Westmorland and Furness Council made an order to enable Cadent Gas to carry out utility works ("the Works) which came into operation on 7th August 2023.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along that section of the Oxenholme Lane, Natland from its junction with Natland Road, extending in a north easterly direction for a distance of approx. 295 metres.

The Works have been rescheduled and will now be carried out under the provisions of the above stated Order on 12th February 2024 and is expected to be in place for an approx. duration of 5 days, as and when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times and a suitable alternative route for vehicles will be signed and available via Oxenholme Lane, A65 and Natland Road.

Nothing in the Order to which this notice relates shall:

- 1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
- 2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
- 3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
- 4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Works.
