

ADVISORY NOTICE

WESTMORLAND AND FURNESS COUNCIL

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF ALL TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

(C5051, CHURCH STREET BROUGHTON-IN-FURNESS)

Westmorland and Furness Council made an order to enable Electricity North West to carry out utility works ("the Works) which came into operation on 18th March 2024.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along that section of the C5051, Church Street, Broughton-In-Furness, from its junction with Griffin Street, extending in a westerly direction for approx. 90 m.

The Works have been rescheduled and will now be carried out under the provisions of the above stated Order on 7th May 2024 and is expected to be in place for an approx. duration of 1 week, as and when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

A suitable alternative route for vehicles will be signed and available as follows;


East bound traffic: Via the unrestricted section of Church Street, A595, C5009, Keppleway Hill, Market Street, Station Road, Prince's Street and Griffin Street.

West bound traffic: Via Griffin Street, Market Street, Keppleway Hill, C5009, A595 and the unrestricted section of Church Street.

Nothing in the Order to which this notice relates shall:

1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Works.
