

ADVISORY NOTICE

WESTMORLAND AND FURNESS COUNCIL (B6277 GARRIGILL ROAD, ALSTON)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF ALL TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

Westmorland and Furness Council made an order to enable utility works to be carried out ("the Works") which came into operation on 7th January 2025.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit all traffic (i.e. vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists) from proceeding along that section of the B6277 Garrigill Road, Alston from its junction with the C3040, extending in a north westerly direction for approx. 430 metres.

The Works have been rescheduled and will be carried out under the provisions of the above stated Order on 28th March 2025, with the restriction expected to be in place for an approx. duration of 5 days, as and when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

A suitable alternative route will be signed and made available via the B6277, B6278 and the A689. It has been identified that it will not be safe to maintain access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists throughout the restriction.
