ADVISORY NOTICE

WESTMORLAND AND FURNESS COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS IN WESTMORLAND AND FURNESS)

(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) (NO.21) ORDER 2024

Westmorland and Furness Council made an order to enable utility works to be carried out ("the Works") which came into operation on 1st December 2024.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along those lengths of road specified within its schedule, but only in respect of Number 6; B5281 Broughton Beck from its junction with A5092 extending in a south easterly direction for a distance of approx. 2.7km.

The Works have been rescheduled and will be carried out under the provisions of the above stated Order on 11th July 2025, with the restriction expected to be in place for an approx. duration of 3 days, as and when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

A suitable alternative route will be signed and made available via

<u>South east bound traffic</u>: via the A5092, A590, Swan Street, Hart Street and Fountain Street and the unrestricted section of the B5281.

<u>Alternative Route - north west bound traffic:</u> via the unrestricted of B5281, King Street, Queen Street, A590 and A5092. A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.
