## **ADVISORY NOTICE**

## WESTMORLAND AND FURNESS COUNCIL (U5142, BAYCLIFF, ALPINE ROAD, NEWLAND, U5101, LOWICK GREEN AND THE A593 BROUGHTON-IN-FURNESS) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024

Westmorland and Furness Council made an order to enable utility works to be carried out ("the Works") which came into operation on 17th October 2024.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along those lengths of road specified within its schedule, but only in respect of Number 4; A593 Broughton in Furness from its junction with High Cross Brow (A595), extending in a north easterly direction to its junction with the C5008.

The Works have been rescheduled and will be carried out under the provisions of the above stated Order on 10th August 2025, with the restriction expected to be in place for an approx. duration of 6 days, as and when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

A suitable alternative route will be signed and made available via the unrestricted section of the A593, Hollow West, A5084, A5092, Wreaks Causeway and the A595. A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.
