

ADVISORY NOTICE

WESTMORLAND AND FURNESS COUNCIL (B6261 SHAP AND THE A592 GLENRIDDING) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024

Westmorland and Furness Council made an order to enable highway works to be carried out ("the Works") which came into operation on 7th October 2024.

The effect of the Order is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along those lengths of road specified within its schedule, but only in respect of Number 2 (i); that section of the A592, Glenridding, from its junction with Park Brow (A5091), extending in a south westerly then southerly direction to its junction with Greenside Road.

The Works have been rescheduled and will be carried out under the provisions of the above stated Order on 27th October 2025, with the restriction expected to be in place for an approx. duration of 2 days, as and when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

A suitable alternative route will be signed and made available as follows;

Alternative Route for north bound traffic: via the unrestricted section of the A592, Patterdale Road, A591, Lake Road, Wansfell Road, Rothay Road (A593), Compston Road, Rydal Road (A591), A66, A5091 and Park Brow.

Alternative Route for west / south east bound traffic: via Park Brow, A5091, A66, Rydal Road (A591), Market Place, Lake Road, Patterdale Road and the unrestricted section of the A592.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.
