

WESTMORLAND AND FURNESS COUNCIL (CHURCH HILL, ARNSIDE AND CROSS STREET, KENDAL) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable utility works to be carried out (“the Works”), Westmorland and Furness Council intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along the following sections of road:

1. Church Hill, Arnside, from its junction with Oakroyd Close, extending in a south easterly direction to its junction with Colesberg Court.

There is no suitable alternative route for vehicles available.

**Duration: From 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2024 for approx. 1 day (Ref: TTROW/12150)**

2. Cross Street, Kendal, from its junction with Burneside Road, extending in a westerly direction to its junction with Union Street.

Alternative Route: via Union Street, Windermere Road (A5284) and Burneside Road.

**Duration: From 29<sup>th</sup> November 2024 for approx. 1 day (Ref: TTROW/12305)**

The Order will come into operation on 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2024 and may continue in force for a maximum duration of eighteen months. However, please note that it is anticipated that the restrictions will only be required as detailed above, and only as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.
