

WESTMORLAND AND FURNESS COUNCIL (ORCHARD ROAD, ARNSIDE AND  
HOLMEFIELD, HOLME) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2026

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable utility works to be carried out ("the Works"), Westmorland and Furness Council intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along the following sections of road:-

- (i) Orchard Road, Arnside, from its junction with Silverdale Road, extending in a north easterly direction for a distance of approx. 125m.

Alternative Route: via Silverdale Road and the unrestricted section of Orchard Road.

**Duration: From 12<sup>th</sup> February 2026 for approx. 5 days (Ref: TTROW/17178)**

- (ii) Holmefield, Holme, from its junction with the B6384 Burton Road, extending in a westerly direction for a distance of approx. 40m.

There is no suitable alternative route available for vehicles.

**Duration: From 17<sup>th</sup> February 2026 for approx. 1 week (Ref: TTROW/17180)**

The Order will come into operation on 12<sup>th</sup> February 2026 and may continue in force for a maximum duration of eighteen months. However, please note that it is anticipated that the restrictions will only be required as detailed above, and only as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.
