

WESTMORLAND AND FURNESS COUNCIL (B6277, ALSTON) (TEMPORARY  
PROHIBITION OF ALL TRAFFIC) ORDER 2025

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable utility works to be carried out (“the Works”), Westmorland and Furness Council intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit all traffic (i.e. vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists), from proceeding along that section of the B6277, Alston, from a point approx. 120 metres south east of its junction with the C3040, extending in a south easterly direction for approx. 100 metres.

A suitable alternative route will be signed and available via the unrestricted sections of the B6277, A689, B6278 and the B6282.

The Order will come into operation on 21<sup>st</sup> January 2025 and may continue in force for a maximum duration of eighteen months. However, please note that it is anticipated that the restriction will only be required for **3 days** and only as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.
