

WESTMORLAND AND FURNESS COUNCIL (C5041 FIELD BROUGHTON, U5090
BURLINGTON CLOSE, KIRBY IN FURNESS AND C5022 PENNY BRIDGE)
(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable utility works to be carried out ("the Works"), Westmorland and Furness Council intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along the following sections of road:

1. C5041 Field Broughton, from a point approx. 440m southwest of its junction with Pease Close Lane, extending in a southerly direction for a distance of approx. 180m.

Alternative Route: via the unrestricted sections of the C5041, A590 and B5278.

Duration: From 26th November 2024 for approx. 2 days (Ref: TTROW/12203)

2. U5090 Burlington Close, Kirkby-in-Furness, from a point approx. 65m south east of its junction with the A595, extending in a north easterly direction for a distance of approx. 25m.

There is no suitable alternative route.

Duration: From 10th December 2024 for approx. 2 days (Ref: TTROW/12438)

3. C5022 Penny Bridge, from its junction with The Rake, extending in a north easterly direction to its junction with Ellis Wood.

Alternative Route: via the unrestricted sections of the C5022, A5092 and A590.

Duration: From 10th December 2024 for approx. 2 days (Ref: TTROW/12470)

The Order will come into operation on 26th November 2024 and may continue in force for a maximum duration of eighteen months. However, please note that it is anticipated that the restrictions will only be required as detailed above, and only as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.
