

WESTMORLAND AND FURNESS COUNCIL (C5097 LEIGHTON BECK ROAD,
BEETHAM, U5623 MEATHOP, AND C5041 STAVELEY IN CARTMEL) (TEMPORARY
TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable utility works to be carried out (“the Works”), Westmorland and Furness Council intends to make an Order the effect of which is to:-

1. Prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along that section of the C5097 Leighton Beck Road, Beetham, from its junction with the C5099, extending in a north easterly direction for a distance of approx. 70m.

Alternative Route: via the unrestricted section of the C5097, A6, C5098 and C5099.

Duration: From 26th November 2024 for approx. 1 day (Ref: TTROW/12423)

2. Prohibit all traffic (i.e. vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists) from proceeding the following sections of road:-

- (i) U5623 Meathop, from a point approx.500m north east and then south west of its junction with Meathop Road, extending in a north easterly direction for a distance of approx.1.2km.

Alternative Route for all traffic: via the unrestricted sections of U5623 and the A590.

Duration: From 6th January 2024 for approx. 7 weeks (Ref: TTROW/12072)

- (ii) C5041 Staveley-in-Cartmel, from a point approx.155m southwest of its junction with the A592, extending in a southerly direction for a distance of approx.100m.

Alternative Route for all traffic: via the unrestricted sections of the C5041, A590 and A592.

Duration: From 6th January 2024 for approx. 5 days (Ref: TTROW/12634)

The Order will come into operation on 26th November 2024 and may continue in force for a maximum duration of eighteen months. However, please note that it is anticipated that the restrictions will only be required as detailed above, and only as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.
