NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable highway works to be carried out ("the Works"), Westmorland and Furness Council intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along that section of Kepplewray Hill, Broughton-In-Furness, from its junction with High Kepplewray, extending in a north westerly direction for approx. 60 m.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.

The Order will come into operation on 26th June 2024 and may continue in force for a maximum duration of eighteen months. However, please note that it is anticipated that the restriction will only be required for **3 days** and only as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.
