NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable BT Openreach to carry out utility works ("the Works"), Westmorland and Furness Council intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along that section of the U5067, Lodge Terrace, Broughton-In-Furness from its junction with Market Street, extending in a north easterly direction to its junction with Timber Hill.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times and a suitable alternative route for vehicles will be signed and available via the unrestricted sections of the U5067, and Market Street.

Nothing in the Order to which this notice relates shall:

- 1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
- 2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
- 3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the road, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the road; and
- 4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Works.

The Order will come into operation on 14th December 2023 and may continue in force for a maximum duration of eighteen months. However, please note that it is anticipated that the restriction will only be required for **1 day** and only as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.
