WESTMORLAND AND FURNESS COUNCIL (A593 CROFT END, BROUGHTON IN FURNESS) (TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Westmorland and Furness Highways to carry out highway works ("the Works"), Westmorland and Furness Council intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along that section of the A593 Croft End, Broughton in Furness from its junction with the C5010, extending in north easterly direction for a distance of approx. 720 metres.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times and a suitable alternative route for vehicles will be signed and available via the A593, A5084, A5092 and A595.

Nothing in the Order to which this notice relates shall:

- 1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
- 2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
- 3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the road, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the road; and
- 4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Works.

The Order will come into operation on 19th June 2023 and may continue in force for a maximum duration of eighteen months. However, please note that it is anticipated that the restriction will only be required for 2 days between the hours of 0830 and 1700 and only as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.
