NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Westmorland and Furness Highways to carry out highway works ("the Works"), Westmorland and Furness Council intends to make an Order the effect of which is to prohibit all traffic (i.e. vehicles, pedestrians and cyclists), from proceeding along the following lengths of road:-

- A5092 Gawthwaite: From a point approx. 130m north east of its junction with the B5281 extending in a north easterly direction for approx. 970m.
 Alternative route: via the unrestricted sections of the A5092, A590 and the A595.

 Approx. duration 2 nights (Ref: TTRO/7564)
- 2. <u>A593 Broughton-in-Furness</u>: From its junction with High Cross Brow (A595) extending in a north easterly direction for a distance of approx. 2.1km. <u>Alternative Route</u>: via the unrestricted sections of the A593, A5084, A5092 and the A595. **Approx. duration 3 nights (Ref: TTRO/7568)**
- A595 Soutergate: From its junction with Askewgate Brow extending in a southerly direction for a distance of approx. 4km.
 Alternative Route: via the unrestricted sections of the A595, A590 and the A5092.
 Approx. duration 3 weeks (Ref: TTRO/7429)
- A595 Foxfield: From its junction with the C5009 extending in a south westerly direction for a distance of approx. 1.6km.
 Alternative Route: via the unrestricted sections of the A595, A593, A5084 and the A5092

Approx. duration 17 days (Ref: TTRO/7694)

The above closures will not necessarily be done in numerical order.

Westmorland and Furness Highways will ensure that local residents and the general public are informed of which roads are to be closed and when, nearer the time.

Nothing in the Order to which this notice relates shall:

- 1. Apply to emergency personnel and emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
- 2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
- 3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads: and
- 4. Apply to personnel and vehicles being used in connection with the Works.

The Order will come into operation on 25th September 2023 and may continue in force for a maximum duration of eighteen months. However, please note that it is anticipated that the restrictions will only be required for 3 months only as and when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.
